

**BARBOUR COUNTY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION**  
**BROADDUS HOSPITAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND**  
**GUIDELINES**

**Objective:** To help address the healthcare needs of Barbour County, WV and to further the educational opportunities of qualified individuals seeking careers in a healthcare field.

**Summary:** A limited number of annual scholarships in the amount of at least \$500 will be offered, as income is available. Distribution will be made directly to the educational institution in two semi-annual installments. The selection committee will consist of a sub-committee of the Broaddus Hospital Board of Trustees and the hospital administrator. Distributions may be made out of the principal of the fund following special approval of the Hospital Board and letter of request to the Foundation. (Exception to Section 3.2 of Foundation Agreement). The scholarship will be publicized at Philip Barbour High School, in the Barbour Democrat and hospital newsletter, and through other media as deemed appropriate. All selections will be made without regard to race, color, religion, national origin, sex, marital status or any other legally protected status.

**Criteria:**

1. Recipients must be a current resident of Barbour County, WV, or a Broaddus Hospital Employee. Preference will be given to Broaddus Hospital employees with a minimum of 1-year seniority and their dependants.
2. Recipients must be pursuing a degree or certificate in a health care related field. Preference will be given to participants in entry-level Clinical Degree/Certificate programs.
3. Recipients must be attending an accredited college, university or institution.
4. Subsequent/repeat scholarships will require a cumulative GPA of "B" (3 quality pts) or better, and will require a re-application on an annual basis. Preference for subsequent/repeat scholarships will be given to those who continue to work at Broaddus Hospital on at least a part-time basis or during holiday/summer breaks as needed.
5. Applicants will submit a written application and may be asked to present for a personal interview.

**Application Deadline:** April 15th 2011 (turn in to your counselor)

**Award:** \$250/semester for 2 semesters
